
Report Rangoli Competition



- 8. First winner was 'Bid Ankita Kishor' from F.Y.B.com and Second winner was 'Nagda Dimple' from S.Y.B.com










Figure 2 Participants of Mehandi Competition




Figure 1 Winner for Poster Competition









Outcome: -


At the end, sheets were collected from the students and keys were solved and correct answers were disclosed by Ms. Aiman.

Objectives: The objectives of conducting competition:




Report One Day Study visit at Konkan Mahotsav



There after lunch was served at the Dairy Plant.







Everyone checked out of the hotel and left for the Thivim Railway station – reaching there by 2:30 p.m.



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



- 4. The programme was organized and conducted successfully.






