





Students with zero percent attendance should not be issued hall tickets and be debarred from exam. Students with upto 50% attendance shall be given assignment works.

She also discussed that innovative methods should be implemented in teaching methods so that students are inclined towards lecture. New ideas should be percolated in their minds.

Principal instructed the attendance committee to send letters to the parents informing the defaulter status of their wards. Undertaking from the parents should be taken and also their feedbacks about the meeting should be taken in proper way. - After chairman's blessing words, the grant event began.


#### DAY-1
