ROAD REPAIR

TREE PLANTATION

To spread awareness on the relationship of trees and environment, Tree Plantation activity was conducted on 22[™] July 2017 with the help of BNCMC gardening department near to Varaldevi Talav and BNN College.





WATER SURVEY AND RALLY

A rally was conducted by the students on 1st September, 2017 to spread the awareness regarding water consumption and water salvation.





RAIN WATER HARVESTING SURVEY

To Conduct a survey and spread awareness regarding 'Rain water harvesting' survey two on 2nd August, 2018. The volunteers communicated with local people and gained information regarding the implementation of Rain water Harvesting techniques in different areas of Bhiwandi.



TREE PLANTATION

WALKATHON KAMWARI SWACHCHATA ABHIYAN

On 26th January, 2021, Walkathon Kamwari Swachchhata Abhiyan was organized by the NSS unit from college to Court naka (Magistrate office). A Memorandum was handed over to Shri Mohan Naladkar, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bhiwandi Region to help in the revival of the river and other water bodies. Thereafter Jan Poojan was performed with help of Self Help Group Shelar village on kamwari river at Tilak Ghat with Haldi -kumkum and offering saree. The programme was attended by Shelar village Gram Sevak and others. This was mainly done to bring attention of authorities towards the hyacinth grown in the waterbody due to pollution and need to start desiltation of river Kamvari so as to save people from flash floods which may occur during monsoon.





KAMWARI SWACHCHATA ABHIYAN(TILAK GHAT NADI NAKA)

The Kamwari river cleaning Movement was held at Tilak Ghat, Nadi Naka on 4th February, 2021. Under the guidance of Jalnayak Dr. SnehalDonde, the NSS students of the college and Aqsa College visited the Tilak Ghat with Shelar village Officials, Tehsildar and other officers and initiated garbage cleaning.





KAMWARI SWACHCHATA ABHIYAN(MILA GHAT MILAT NAGAR)

On 11th Feb. 2021, the Dr. Snehal Donde along with staff and NSS volunteers visited Millat Ghat (Kamwari river bank) at Millat Nagar. NSS Volunteers and Staff of Bhiwandi Corporation Health Dept. conducted a cleaning drive and with support from the New commissioner a JCB machine for cleaning the river was arranged. The NSS volunteers conducted a rally from Tilak Ghat to Millat Ghat creating awareness regarding water conservation.





A VISIT TO ULHAS RIVER AT SARAVLI

On 22rd March, 2021 The NSS volunteers along with Jalanayak Prin. Dr. Snehal Donde visited the Ulhas River at Sarawli village, Bhiwandi and performed Nadi Darshan at Ulhas river. They observed the River pollution effluents released directly by Textile & Milk Unit and Paper mill in MIDC area. The discharge in the river thereby polluted the river water soil and vegetation beyond imagination. They found three-four location of releasing of polluted water into river without treatment. The Jal Darshan was done with the help of local activist Rahul Mukadam. Students pledged that they will take the ownership to correct the pollution issues and ensure that more awareness is created among the locals
