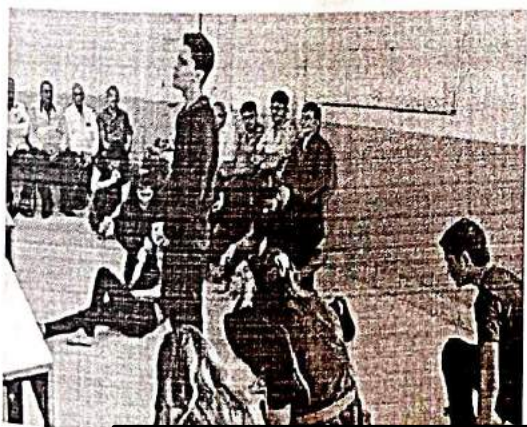

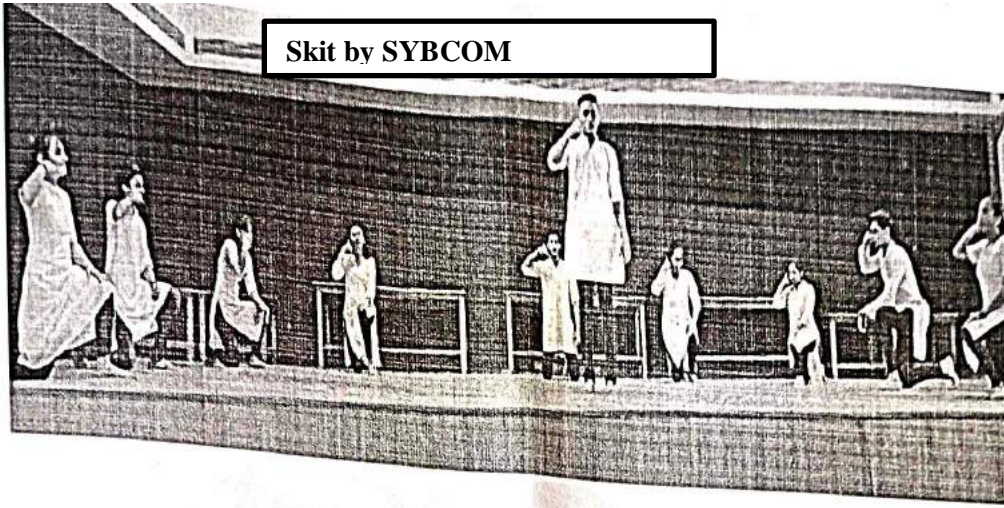


1. The students invited for the session were from the SYBAF class including the faculties.

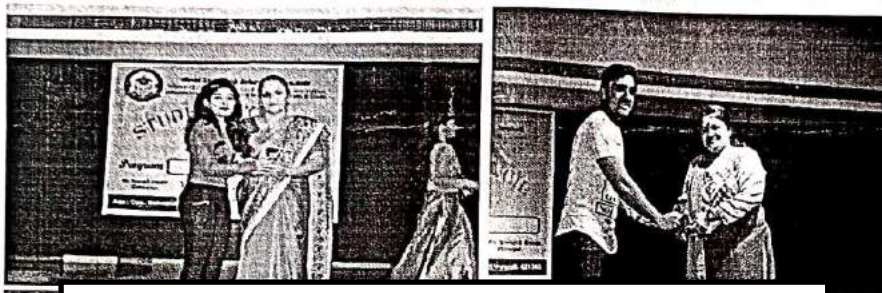
Report On 'Freshers' Party'

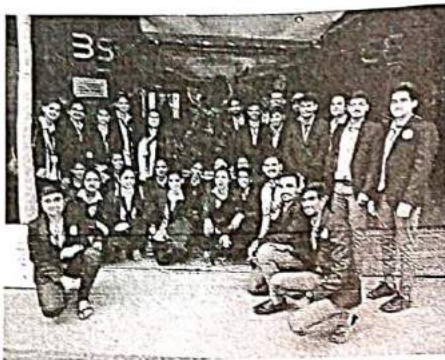

- v. The One Day Industrial Visit proved to be fruitful.

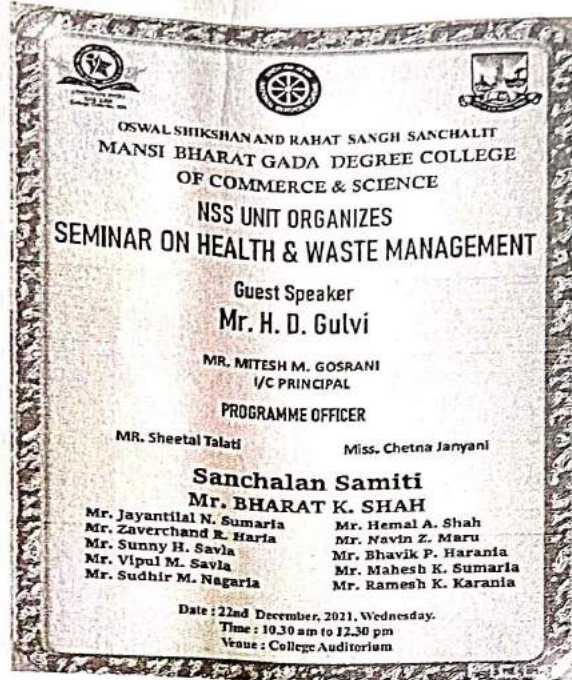

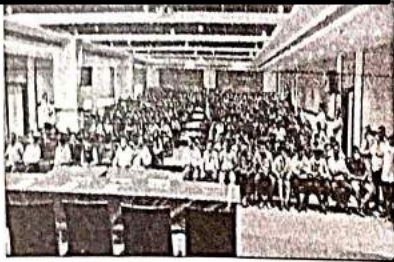
Details:

There they learned about the process of making milk and Ice-cream.

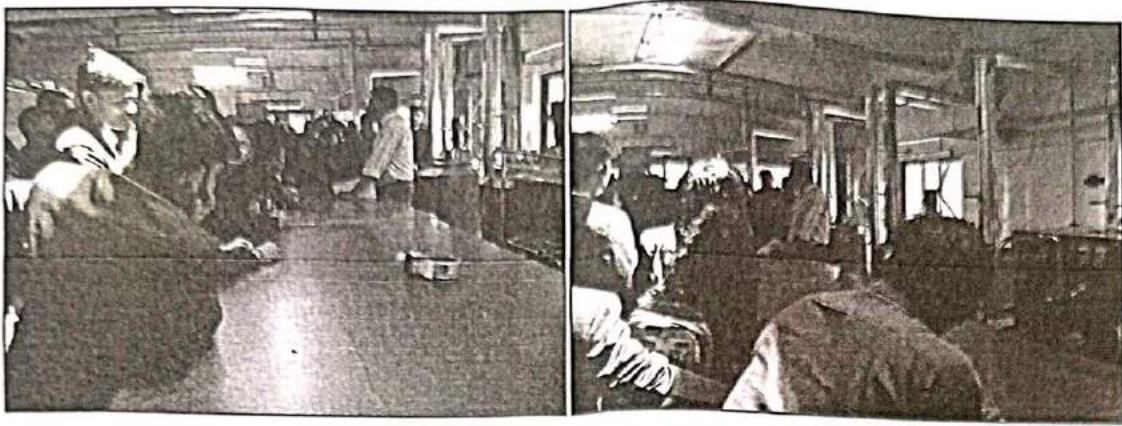
There after lunch was served at the Dairy Plant.

They reached the hotel again by 12:00 p.m. and lunch was served in the hotel at 12:45 p.m.

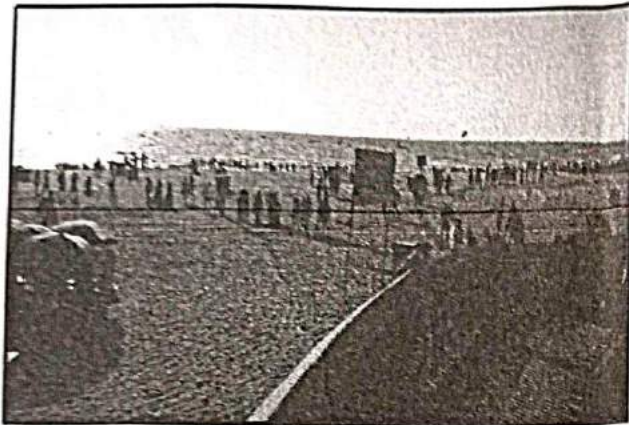
Everyone checked out of the hotel and left for the Thivim Railway station – reaching there by 2:30 p.m.
