Courses:

Courses affiliated to University of Mumbai

The college has B.com programme since 2009. The University approved college proposal for starting B.Com (Accounting & Finance) in the Academic Year 2019-2020. In the First year of B.Com In Accounting & Finance total 32 students enrolled against sanctioned capacity of 60 Students.

Courses affiliated to Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University

The college is running B.P.P. (Bachelors Preparatory Programme), M.Com and M.B.A as distance learning courses.

Certificate Courses:

Certificate course in Direct Tax, Certificate course in computerized accounting and tally, Certificate course in Forensic Accounting was started for F.Y., S.Y. and T.Y.B.Com students as special skill development courses.

Special Skill Development courses:

As per the MoU signed with the Express Industries Council of India (EICI) to start skill development courses in Logistics sector, the college opted seven job roles under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY). For this Training of trainers programme was conducted for college staff from 27th to 31st May, 2019. The trainer from Logistic Skill Council of India (LSC) Mr. Barucha (Corporate Trainer) conducted training for Seven job roles of Consignment Booking, Consignment tracking, Courier Delivery Executive, Warehouse Picker, Warehouse Picker, Inventory Clerk and Documentation Assistant, etc

The infrastructure for providing training to candidates was developed on the second floor of the college building by converting four class rooms into 11 skill development classroom, lab and hybrid classrooms. The infrastructure development work was completed by sept. 2019.

Special Case:

In the Year 2019-2020, the unexpected and unfortunate incident shook the college in August, 2019. The TYBCom Students who had not paid the fees of certificate course in Forensic Accounting, revoked against the course and Protested in front of college gate. The Two students who seem to be leader of the class provoked other students to join them.

Mr. Anup Chaudhary (TYBCOM) due to his short tempered ness and arrogant behavior with Principal and staff was sent for taking treatment on anger management as his aggressive behavior led to the damaging college properties. He was advised to go to recognized counselor for the treatment and after completion of satisfactory treatment and producing certificate, he was allowed to join the college. Despite of this, when he was coming to the college, it was decided to give him LC for non compliance of the condition. The another student Ms. Twinkle Anchan (TYBCOM) with the help of Mr. Anup had protested against the college rules and the Principal with other TYBCom students. They involved media people, local politicians and social media (WhatsApp, Instagram, etc..) by keeping college reputation at stake. Finally, Mr. Anup was given NOC and suspension letter was issued to Twinkle for restricting them to enter in the college premises.

The case of Anup Chudhary and Twinkle Anchan was escalated to media by them which was streamed on You tube on 1 st Sept. 2019. It got viral among other college students and faculties with more than 8000 views. To combat this defamatory action police complaint was lodged against you tube reporter in Narpoli police station.

भिवंडी : भिवंडी शहराच्या उत्तरेकडून वाहणारी कामवारी नदी आता कोरडी झाली आहे. तिचा प्रवाह खंडित झाल्याने ही नदी प्रदूषित व मृतावस्थेत झाली आहे. त्यासाठी कामवारी नदीच्या उपभागातून ते शेवटपर्यंत वेगवेगळ्या गटात अभ्यास करणे आवश्यक आहे. नदीच्या किनारी दोन्ही बाजूकडील अनधिकृत बांधकामे हटविणे, नदीमध्ये सोडले जाणारे सांडपाणी, रासायनिक प्रदूषित मिश्रित पाणी बंद करणे आवश्यक आहे. या नदीचे पुनरुज्जीवित करून प्रवाहित करायचे असेल तर या नदीच्या स्वच्छतेकडे लक्ष देणारे स्वतंत्रपणे वेगळे प्राधिकरण काढावे लागेल असे उद्गार जलपुरुष राजेंद्रसिंह यांनी काढले.

भिवंडी महापालिका, ओएसवाल महाविद्यालय यांच्या संयुक्त विद्यमाने कामवारी नदी बचाव पुनर्वसन करण्यासाठी एका कार्यशाळेचे आयोजन ओएसवाल वाणिज्य महाविद्यालयात करण्यात आले होते. त्यावेळी राजेंद्रसिंहजी प्रमुख पाहुणे म्हणून बोलत होते. राजेंद्रसिंह पुढे म्हणाले की, कोणत्याही नदीचे पुनरुज्जीवन होण्यासाठी समाजाने सरकारवर दबाव वाढवणे आवश्यक असते. याकरिता सामाजिक चळवळ उभी राहणे आवश्यक आहे.

भिवंडी. कामवारी नदी बचाओ अभियान के तहत सोमवार को

भिवंडी आए मंगसेसे पुरस्कार विजेता डा. राजेंद्र सिंह ने कामवारी नदी की दुर्दशा के लिए भिवंडी मनपा, ग्राम पंचायत और एमएमआरडीए की आपसी खींचतान और टालू खेचें को जिम्मेदार बताया है। उन्होंने कहा कि साझेपन की भावना से एक स्वतंत्र संसद या प्राधिकरण बनाकर कामवारी का पुनरोद्धार और जीवित किया जा सकता है। कामवारी नदी के तट पर उन्होंने

पत्रकारों को बताया कि जब नदी मरती है तो नाला बनती है। उसमें हालत तो नाला से भी बदतर है। सिंह ने कामवारी की पुनर्जीवित करने के लिए सबसे सरल उपाय यह बताया कि जिस गंदगी के कारण उसके रिचार्जिंग प्लॉट बंद हो गए हैं, उन्हें चार्ज करना चाहिए उसे खोलना और उसकी सफाई करनी चाहिए। इस तरह बारिश के दिनों में जो पानी आता है। उसे जगह-जगह रिचार्ज करना चाहिए। उनके मुताबिक नदी के पत्थरों में अभी जान है। जो इस बात का प्रमाण है कि नदी को रिचार्ज करने की क्षमता और ताकत है। इसके मीठे जल को रिचार्ज करके खारा और दूषित जल को ड्राइल्यूट किया जा सकता है।

डाइल्यूशन में ही सल्यूशन है

कई बार मीठा पानी खारे और गंदे पानी को ड्रायल्यूट कर देता है। उन्होंने भिवंडी मनपा को निशाने पर लेते हुए कहा कि मुझे लगता है कि मनपा ने इसके समाधान के लिए जिस तरह से काम करना चाहिए वैसा किया नहीं। जिससे नदी दिन-ब-दिन मरती और खराब होती जा रही है। उद्ग्राम से लेकर संगम तक दोनों तरफ की नदी को पुनर्जीवित किया जा सकता है। भिवंडी मनपा आयुक्त मनोहर हिरे, यशदा के निदेशक डा. सुमंत पांडेय, हालारी विशा की प्राध्याया डॉ. रूनेहल एस. दोंडे, शाब्बीर पाईपवाला और दिलीप काकवीकर आदि मौजूद थे।
